1. Short title

This exemption may be cited as the General Liquor Exemption (No.1) 1991.

2. Commencement

This exemption takes effect on 01 April 1991.

3. Authorization

Subject to clause 4 the sale of liquor by commercial caterers is authorized.

4. Conditions

The authorization granted by clause 3 is subject to the following conditions:-

- that the liquor sold is only sold as an adjunct to food provided by the caterer;
- that the provision of food and the sale of the liquor is in respect of a social function or a business function;
- that at least 25 persons who have attained the age of 18 years are invited to the function;
- that the provision of food and the sale of liquor at the function is provided in furtherance of a contract between the caterer and the person holding the function;
- that the liquor sold at the function is provided to people at the function at the expense of the person holding the function.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the general liquor exemption)

The purpose of this exemption is to allow *bona fide* caterers to sell liquor without the need to hold a liquor licence or liquor permit where the sale of the liquor is part of a contract providing for the provision of food and liquor at a social or business function for at least 25 adults

- (b) an executor; or
- (c) an administrator –

of a deceased person's estate is authorized.

4 Condition

The authorization granted by clause 3 is subject to the condition that the liquor sold is only sold in furtherance of the winding up of the deceased person's estate.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the general liquor exemption).

The purpose of this exemption is to allow liquor which forms part of a deceased person's estate to be sold by people administering the estate, without the need to hold a liquor licence or liquor permit.

4. Condition

The authorization granted by clause 3 is subject to the condition that the liquor sold is only sold in accordance with powers given in respect of the bankrupt's estate by the Bankruptcy Act 1966.

The purpose of this exemption is to allow liquor which forms part of a deceased person's estate to be sold by people administering the estate, without the need to hold a liquor licence or liquor permit

The purpose of this exemption is to allow proprietors of restaurants to sell coffee with liquor added without the need to hold a liquor licence or liquor permit.

- is of the guest house type; and
- is not capable of accommodating more than 10 tourists or travellers at any one time.

4. Condition

The authorization granted by clause 3 is subject to the condition that the liquor sold is only sold as an adjunct to meals served by the licensee to people accommodated at the premises specified in the accommodation licence.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the general liquor exemption)

The purpose of this exemption is to allow the proprietors of certain small guest houses (i.e. those that can accommodate no more than 10 people) to sell liquor with meals provided to guests at the accommodation.

The exemption only applies if the premises are specified in an accommodation licence.

The purpose of this exemption is to allow liquor sales at Senior Secondary Colleges only when such liquor is sold as part of an approved Catering course offered under the Schools Board of Tasmania syllabus.

4. Conditions

4.1. That liquor is sold only to a resident of the nursing home or hostel.

4.2. That liquor sold is consumed only on the nursing home or hostel premises.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The purpose of this exemption is to authorize the sale of liquor to a resident of a nursing home or hostel which provides aged care facilities.

- that the liquor sold is only sold as an adjunct to food provided by the caterer;
- that the provision of food and the sale of the liquor is in respect of a social function or a business function;
- that all persons involved in the service of liquor at a catered function have successfully undertaken a recognised training course dealing with the responsible service of alcohol;
- that the provision of food and the sale of liquor at the function is provided in furtherance of a contract between the caterer and the person holding the function; and
- that the liquor sold at the function is provided to people at the function at the expense of the person holding the function.

Rescission

General Liquor Exemption (No. 1) 1991 is hereby rescinded from 1 July 2005.
