

## 1. Absentee Population

This factor is an allowance for the additional population that must be serviced within a municipality, when the additional population does not live in that municipality on a permanent basis.

Absentee Population CA currently applies to four expenditure categories which are:

- general administration;
- planning and community amenities;
- waste management and environment; and
- recreation and culture.

The major positive impact of this CA applies to those municipalities that have a high number of holiday residences. The data upon which this CA is calculated will be updated for the 2009-10 FAG recommendations using 2006 Census data.

### Impacts of Updated CA Data

Updating the unoccupied dwelling data to include the 2006 Census will alter the distribution pattern of this CA depending on the trends identified. Appendix 3 shows census data from 2001 and 2006. Columns I to M show the change between the two data years.

Column I & J show that all but two councils experienced an increase in total dwelling numbers. Increases in total dwellings ranged from 8 (Flinders) to 1 204 (Kingborough), while the two decreases were for King Island (53) and West Coast (122). In percentage terms three councils exceeded a ten per cent increase in total dwellings between the two Census results, namely Brighton (+10.64 per cent), Kingborough (10.10 per cent) and Latrobe (10.49 per cent).

As well as there being shifts in total dwellings, there have been some significant changes to the numbers of unoccupied dwellings between 2001 and 2006. Fourteen councils experienced declines in unoccupied dwellings, despite Tasmania experiencing an increase in unoccupied dwellings of 5.56 per cent (cell L118). The largest decreases in unoccupied dwellings occurred for Brighton (-27.87 per cent) and Burnie (-20.80 per cent). The largest increases in unoccupied dwellings was experienced by Glamorgan-Spring Bay (+16.24 per cent) and Latrobe (+16.15 per cent). Central Highlands, Hobart and Kingborough also show double digit percentage increases in unoccupied dwellings over the same period.

Overall, when viewing the proportion of unoccupied dwellings to total properties, 17 councils show a fall between 2001 and 2006 ranging from -5.07 per cent (Flinders) to Central Coast -0.02 per cent. There were 12 increases in the proportion of unoccupied dwellings ranging from +0.04 per cent (Devonport) to 3.30 per cent (Glamorgan-Spring Bay). However, these increases were not enough to outweigh the decreases resulting

in a 2006 Census result of 12.77 per cent unoccupied dwellings which is 0.16 per cent less than the 2001 Census figure.

### CA Impacts

Councils with a CA of more than 1.15 experience significant increases in their non-roads expenditure (Appendix 2, column M) due to this CA. The main beneficiaries are:

These results are explained through the fact that all, with the exception of Flinders, are municipalities that have high numbers of holiday homes.

### West Coast Adjustment

When the 2001 Census data became available to the Commission, West Coast was given a special adjustment for this CA as the 2001 Census data was considered to not properly reflect the situation where mineworkers reside outside the municipality between shifts. An additional 800 dwellings was added to West Coast's unoccupied dwelling data to account for this. This adjustment has been applied to the 2006 Census Data and will be retained within the model.

### Range Factor Adjustment

The Commission determined to increase the effect of the Absentee Population CA by altering the range factor. The effect of this adjustment can be seen between Appendices 1 & 2. In Appendix 1 the maximum impact on applicable expenditure categories is +33.8 per cent for Central Highlands. The Commission, through its broad judgement, altered the range factor to increase this maximum redistribution to +50.0 per cent for Central Highlands. The dollar and percentage impacts to all councils can be observed in columns K & L in Appendix 2.
