IMPORTANT

The information provided below is a brief outline of the rights and responsibilities of parties involved in the exclusion process. The *Gaming Control Act 1993* specifies other obligations on the parties. To obtain further information please contact the Tasmanian Gaming Commission.

RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF EXCLUDED PERSONS

An excluded person must not contravene an Exclusion Order. The penalty for doing so is a fine not exceeding \$2400.

Within 28 days of receiving the Order, a person excluded by a specified licence holder may appeal against the Exclusion Order to the Tasmanian Gaming Commission by writing to the Commission at GPO Box 1374, Hobart Tasmania, 7001.

RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF SPECIFIED LICENCE HOLDERS

A specified licence holder or a person authorised by the licence holder, may exclude a person from entering or remaining on premises where gaming is conducted by the licence holder. The Commissioner of Police may direct the specified licence holder to exclude a person from the venue.

The Tasmanian Gaming Commission must be provided with details of an Exclusion Order, using this form, whether the order is given orally or in writing or made at the direction of the Commissioner of Police. If the excluded person requires an oral Exclusion Order to be made in writing, the licence holder must provide the person with a copy of this form. The oral order is suspended until a copy of the order is provided.

An exclusion order given at the direction of the Commissioner of Police cannot be revoked except with the written approval of the Commissioner of Police. Any other exclusion order remains in force until revoked by the specified licence holder or a person authorised by the specified licence holder, or until the Commission revokes it on appeal by the excluded person.

REMOVAL OF EXCLUDED PERSONS

When a person contravenes an Exclusion Order, the person in charge of a gaming venue or a police officer at the request of the person in charge, using no more force than is reasonably necessary, may remove the person from the venue. An excluded person may also be prevented from entering the venue.

If you have any queries about the completion of, or access to a Self-exclusion Notice of Deed, call a Registered Accredited Provider. Registered Accredited Providers include personal or financial counsellors or group counsellors and other approved professionals. They are located in a number of offices and agencies across the State.
