

Notice to an Applicant for a Liquor Licence

Section 22 of the Liquor Licensing Act 1990 sets the qualifications for the grant of a liquor licence.

Part of the Commissioners consideration for the grant of licence is the applicant's knowledge and experience of responsible serving of alcohol practices and principles.

In this respect either of the following will be accepted in support of an application for the grant or transfer of a liquor licence:-

- (1) RSA Accreditation Certificate; or,
- (2) A completed application form together with appropriate fee for attendance at the next available course conducted by an accredited provider.

If the grant or transfer is approved on an applicant's undertaking to attend the next available course and the applicant fails to complete the course then action will be sought to have the licence suspended until such time as accreditation is obtained.
