

REGULATION OF LICENSED PROVIDERS UNDER THE GAMING CONTROL ACT 1993

PROVISION	ROLL OF RECOGNIZED MANUFACTURERS, SUPPLIERS AND TESTERS OF GAMING EQUIPMENT
SECTION OF THE ACT	69A - 76

EXPLANATION

Suppliers of gaming equipment to holders of Tasmanian Gaming Licences must be on the roll of recognized manufacturers suppliers and testers.

ACT REQUIREMENTS

The Tasmanian Gaming Commission must maintain a "Roll of Recognized Manufactures, Suppliers and Testers of Gaming Equipment". The Commission will require a person to apply to the Commission to be listed on the roll if the person manufactures or supplies, or intends to supply gaming equipment or testing services to a Tasmanian gaming licence holder.

TIMEFRAMES

This provision commences immediately a Tasmanian Gaming Licence is issued.

SUGGESTED PROCESS

For a holder of a Tasmanian gaming licence, any gaming equipment hardware or software which is purpose built for wagering will need to be supplied by a manufacturer who is listed on the roll of recognised manufacturers, suppliers and testers. Purpose built hardware and software would include hardware and software which runs any wagering and sports betting applications.

A Tasmanian Gaming Licence holder should check this list to identify if their current suppliers/testers are listed there. Where they do not appear, they will need to direct their suppliers/testers to complete applications (also found at the above address) to be listed on the roll.

Applications for listing on the roll can take in excess of eight weeks to be finalised.
