

REGULATION OF LICENSED PROVIDERS UNDER THE GAMING CONTROL ACT 1993

PROVISION	SPORTS EVENTS
SECTION OF THE ACT	3(1) “approved sports event” and 3(8)

EXPLANATION

Under the *Gaming Control Act 1993*, wagering on sports events can only be conducted on events that have been approved by the Tasmanian Gaming Commission.

ACT REQUIREMENTS

At the request of a licensed provider, the Commission may declare its approval of a sports event, or a sports event of a class specified, by placing a notice in the *Gazette*.

TIMEFRAMES

This provision commences immediately a Tasmanian Gaming Licence is issued.

SUGGESTED PROCESS

The Commission has approved a number of sports on which wagering can occur. A full list of approved sports are located on the Treasury and Finance website at www.treasury.tas.gov.au.

Gazetting a sports event can take a minimum of seven days, so it is important that any requests for approval are made well in advance of the proposed event.
