



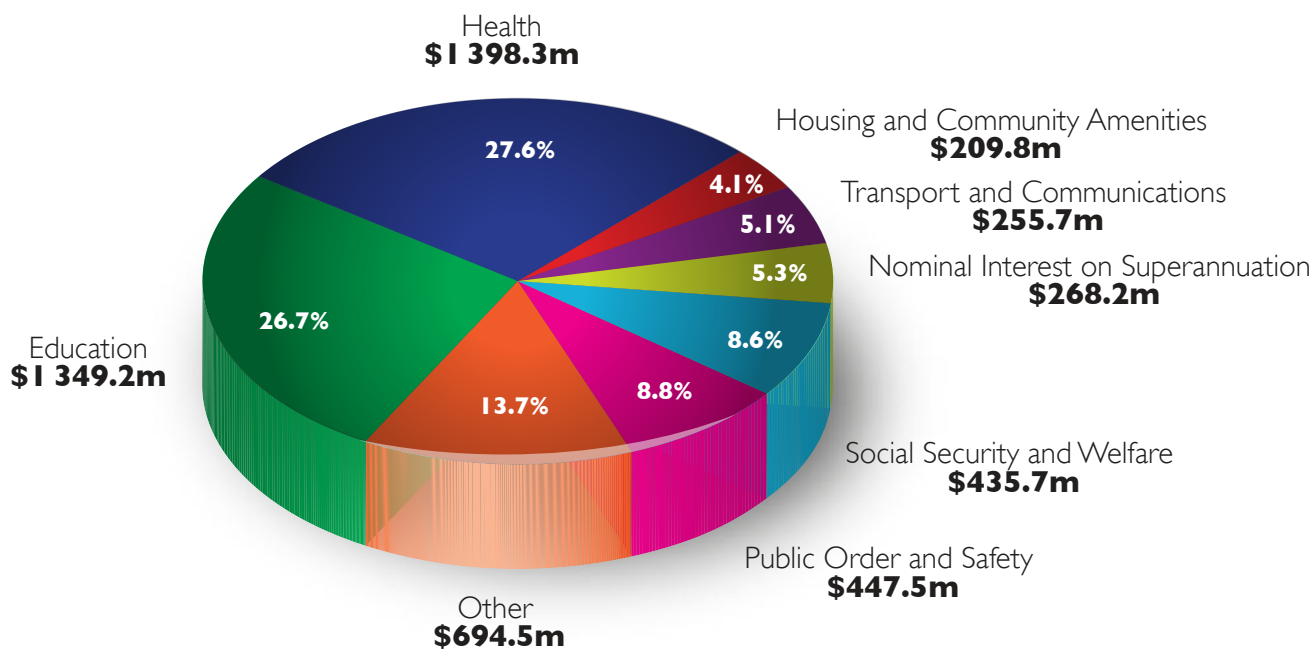

- Prison Infrastructure Redevelopment Program – \$20.2m
