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## **APPROPRIATION BILL (No. 2) 2023**

*(Brought in by the Treasurer, the Honourable Michael Darrel  
Joseph Ferguson)*

### **A BILL FOR**

**An Act for the appropriation of \$47 225 000 out of the  
Public Account for the services of the Government in  
respect of Parliament and Statutory Offices for the  
financial year ending on 30 June 2024**

Be it enacted by Her Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by  
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and  
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

#### **1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act  
(No. 2) 2023*.

#### **2. Commencement**

This Act commences on 1 July 2023, but if it  
does not receive the Royal Assent by that date,  
this Act is taken to have commenced on  
1 July 2023.

#### **3. Interpretation**

For the purposes of this Act –

*Capital Services* means –

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- (a) public works or property required for public purposes; or
- (b) a loan authorised by law;

***Operating Services*** means the ordinary annual services of the Government.

**4. Issue, application and appropriation of \$47 225 000**

- (1) In respect of the financial year ending on 30 June 2024, the Treasurer may –
  - (a) issue the sum of \$47 225 000 out of the Public Account; and
  - (b) apply that sum for the services of the Government.
- (2) The sum specified in subsection (1)(a) is appropriated.

**5. Purposes of appropriation**

The sum specified in section 4(1)(a) is to be applied for the purposes specified in Schedule 1 and detailed in the agency information in support of the estimates for the financial year ending on 30 June 2024.

**6. Expiry of Act**

This Act expires on 30 June 2025.
