

Bingo / Pingo

Conditions of exempt game

In accordance with section 3, subsection 8A of the *Gaming Control Act 1993*, the Tasmanian Liquor and Gaming Commission has declared the following game to be an exempt game:

Bingo / pingo

Bingo or “pingo”, which is played predominantly for social purposes, subject to the following conditions:

1. a single entry fee is charged for a session of bingo or “pingo”, which may include multiple rounds of games for which no additional amount may be charged;
2. the entry fee charged per participant for a session of bingo or “pingo” does not exceed \$30;
3. the retail value of any available prize does not exceed \$300;
4. any proceeds of the game (after deduction for reasonably incurred operational costs, including reasonably incurred cost of prizes) are used for the lawful purposes of a not-for-profit organisation or charitable purpose and not for the private gain or benefit of any person except by way of charity;
5. sufficient information is provided in advance to enable participants to reasonably understand the rules of the game; and
6. sufficient records are retained to reasonably demonstrate compliance with these conditions.
