The Tasmanian Gambling Exclusion Scheme (TGES) helps ensure gaming runs in a responsible way. The scheme provides a means for people to be excluded from gaming activities or in some cases from gaming venues.

The Exclusion Database is an online record of all excluded people in Tasmania. The Database assists licence holders to meet their duties under the scheme.
