

LICENSING BOARD OF TASMANIA

IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION FOR A SPECIAL LICENCE BY GERALD STEPHEN ELLIS, MEADOWBANK WINE CENTRE, DENHOLMS ROAD CAMBRIDGE

DECISION

The Board considered this application on Wednesday 16th February 2000 and heard David Paynter on behalf of the Applicant on Thursday 17th February 2000.

The application meets the guidelines for Tasmanian and Local wines (Vineyard or Winemaker) 5.8 and Special Licence (Restaurant 4.5.1) and the application meets the criteria for the additional component to permit liquor to be sold for consumption on the premises to people attending pre-booked functions, seminars, conferences and receptions.

The Board indicated that in the circumstances it was appropriate (and indeed that the Commissioner had so directed) that the application be notified by signposting in a prominent position visible to the public, on the premises.

Mr Paynter undertook to affix the sign indicating the application to the premises on the 17th February which sign indicates that people may make representations to the Board regarding the licence on or before the 3rd March.

The licensed area includes the Wine Centre, Terrace and external area which is marked ABCD.

The Board's decision is to direct a grant of the licence subject to there being no representations made to the Board by the 3rd March.

If any representation is made to the Board by the 3rd March the Board will reconvene the matter to enable consideration of the representations and due hearing process.
