*General liquor exemption under the Liquor and

The Licensing Board hereby grants the following general liquor exemption under section 16 of the Liquor and Accommodation Act 1990.

1. Short title

This exemption may be cited as the General Liquor Exemption (No.1) 1999.

2. Commencement

This exemption takes effect on 01 June 1999.

3. Authorization

Liquor sold to the master of a ship as a component of ship's stores and/or as stores bound for Antarctic bases is authorized.

4. Conditions

That the sale and supply of liquor is in accordance with any requirements of the Australian Customs Service.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The purpose of this exemption is to authorize people who sell liquor as part of ship's stores or as stores bound for Antarctic bases to do so without holding a liquor licence or permit.

This exemption replaces General Liquor Exemption (No. 2) 1993.
