*General liquor exemption under the Liquor and  
Accommodation Act 1990*

The Licensing Board hereby grants the following general liquor exemption  
under section 16 (1) of the Liquor and Accommodation Act 1990.

**Short title**

1. This exemption may be cited as the General Liquor Exemption (No.1) 1993.

**Commencement**

2. This exemption takes effect on 01 June 1993.

**Authorization**

3. Subject to clause 4 the sale of liquor as part of a liquor tea or mulled wine mixture is authorized.

**Conditions**

4. The authorization granted by clause 3 is subject to the following conditions:-  
that the liquor sold is only sold on premises the primary purpose of which is  
the provision of meals for consumption of those premises; and  
that the liquor tea or mulled wine mixture is only sold for consumption on  
those premises.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the general liquor exemption)*

The purpose of this exemption is to allow proprietors of restaurants to sell tea with liquor added and mulled wine without the need to hold a liquor licence or liquor permit.
