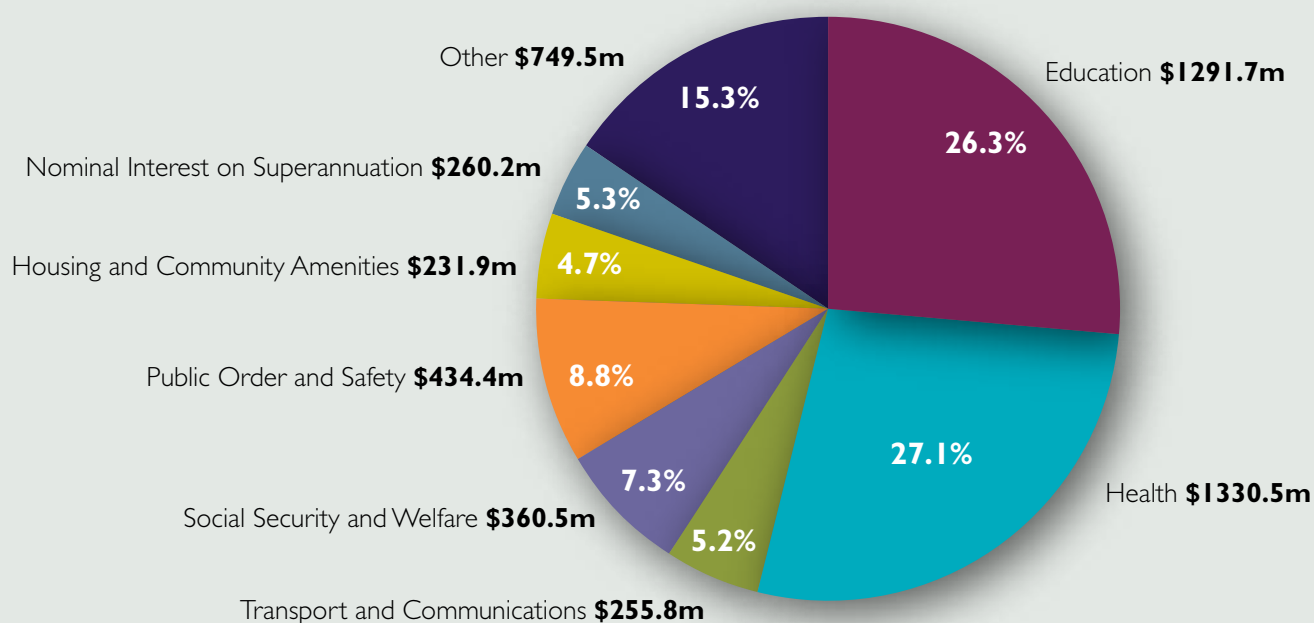

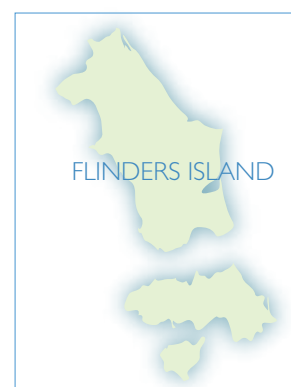

- Tasman Highway upgrading between Scottsdale and Launceston – \$4m
