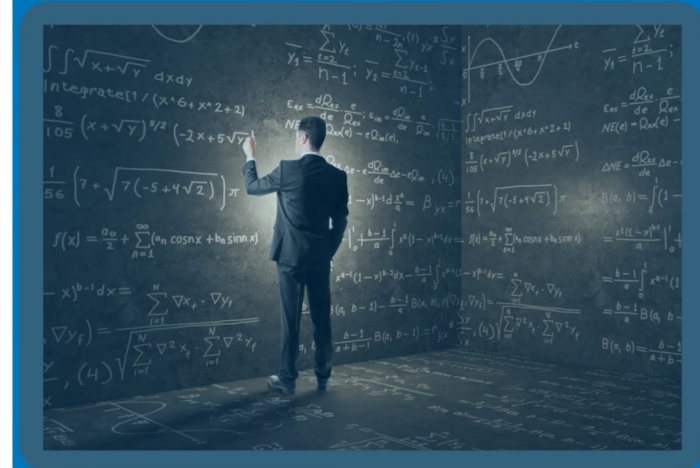

Wagering

Wagering is offered in venues and online and there are many ways to bet.

Wagering operators exist to make a profit. The odds change depending on the team or horse, past performances and conditions on the day.

Keno

Keno is offered in venues and online. Be aware:

- the chances of winning a major prize in keno are very low
- games occur continually so time can pass quickly.

Keno returns 75% of the amount wagered in prizes that means 25% is retained by the operator.

Lotteries and instant scratch-its

Several lotteries and instant scratch tickets are available in Tasmania and online.

The chances of winning the major lottery prize is very low. There is no playing strategy that will increase your chances.

Casino games

Various table games are available at casinos in Tasmania. Each game has its own rules which affect your chances of winning. Casinos make money through the House Edge.

The House Edge is the average amount of every bet that a casino keeps over time. For example, in Roulette the wheel has 37 compartments (numbered 0-36) where the ball may stop when the wheel is spinning. This means there are 37 possibilities. However, the pay out for a straight up bet in Roulette is 35 to 1.

If you placed a \$1 bet on all straight up numbers to guarantee a winning number, it will cost you \$37. You will only get back \$36 (\$35 for the win plus your original \$1 bet on the winning number). The \$1 difference is the House Edge.

Electronic Gaming Machines (poker machines)

Gaming machines are offered in clubs, hotels and casinos in Tasmania. Be aware:

- the chances of a major win are very low
- games are played rapidly so time can pass quickly
- past wins/losses on a gaming machine make no difference to the next game.

In Tasmania, gaming machines must return a minimum of 87% of the total amount bet by players. The machines are set up to return this amount over the entire period a game is in operation, which may be many years. Your chances of getting back 87 cents for every dollar you bet in a session is very low.

Modern gaming machines are controlled by computers. Each spin is independent and generated randomly. It is impossible for a player, for venue staff, or any other factor to influence or predict the results of a game. The symbols are selected as soon as you push the button.

Nothing you do can change the outcome of a game.
