

Private social games

Conditions of exempt game

In accordance with section 3, subsection 8A of the *Gaming Control Act 1993*, the Tasmanian Liquor and Gaming Commission has declared the following game to be an exempt game:

Private social games

Any game played primarily for social purposes, subject to the following conditions:

1. the total contributions do not exceed \$2,000;
2. a single participant does not contribute more than \$250;
3. the total contributions, without any deduction, are distributed to participants as prizes in money or money's worth;
4. the chances of winning are equally favourable for all participants;
5. the game is not promoted or conducted for commercial purposes, or for the private gain or benefit of anyone other than participants; and
6. only a participant can make a profit or gain, and no person who is organising, managing or supervising the activity receives money or other valuable consideration for doing so.
