



Conflict of interest

RBF's commitment

RBF takes the management of conflict of interest very seriously. Not only because the standards expected by regulations are high, but also as it is an important matter for the Tasmanian community to consider and for the Commission to appropriately deal with openly and transparently.

What does RBF's Conflict Management Policy cover?

RBF's Conflict Management Policy applies to any Commissioner of the Superannuation Commission (the trustee of RBF) (Commission) and covers the identification, disclosure, recording, management and avoidance of conflicts. Conflicts may arise from other interests held, or from duties owed to other entities and may be actual or potential.

Staff of the Office of the Superannuation Commission are required to comply with the Department of Treasury and Finance's Conflict of Interest Framework which obliges disclosure of actual and potential conflicts of interest and duty.

Who does RBF's policy apply to?

All Commissioners are obliged to disclose actual and potential conflicts of interest or duty.

RBF promotes the value of proactive disclosure of conflicts. Commissioners are required to disclose any conflicts of interest at each Commission meeting. Once disclosed, conflicts are managed or avoided pursuant to requirements under the *Public Sector Superannuation Reform Act 2016*. 'Relevant' interests or duties are disclosed on the RBF website. An interest or duty is 'relevant' if it might

reasonably be considered to have the potential to have a significant impact on the capacity of the Commissioner with the relevant duty or holding the relevant interest, to act in a manner that is consistent with the best interests of the Fund's members.
