## Decision

The Applicant applies for “Tasmanian Wines – off premises” liquor licence.

The nature of such licence is set out in recent decision “Fresco” of 1 August 2011.

The premises in this instance is a butcher shop.

For the reasons set out in “Fresco”, by analogy, the present application does not fit the licence category. The premises more closely fit the description of a ‘butcher shop’ rather than being a specialised enterprise contemplated by the analysis in “Fresco” regarding this licence category.

The discretion which the Board is obliged to exercise makes it in the best interests of the community that premises such as these under consideration should not generally be licensed for sale of Tasmanian wines for off premises consumption.

We direct the Commissioner to refuse the application.
